FALL GARDENING CHORES

GENERAL CLEAN-UP

RAKE UP LEAVES & BRANCHES. COMPOST IF POSSIBLE

DEADHEAD PERENNIALS

CLEAN UP & REMOVE VEGETABLES & ANNUALS.

PICK-UP FRUIT FROM FRUIT TREES

COVER PATIO FURNITURE OR STORE INSIDE. GOOD TIME TO OIL WOOD.

STORE PLANTERS TO PROTECT FROM FREEZING

MULCH TENDER PLANTS (ROSES, PERENNIALS)

GOOD TIME TO ADD AMEND WITH ORGANIC MATERIAL

LAWN CARE

FERTILIZE WITH WINTERIZER TYPES.

AERATION

THATCH IF NECESSARY

APPLY SOIL ACTIVATOR

RESEED THIN OR BARE SPOTS

RAISE MOWER HEIGHT TO MIN OF 2 ½ INCHES. MOW UNTIL COMPLETELY DORMANT

PLANTING

BEST TIME OF THE YEAR TO PLANT TREES, SHRUBS & PERENNIALS.

PLANT BULBS FOR SPRING BLOOMS (TULIPS, DAFFODILS, CROCUS etc.)

PLANT ONIONS & GARLIC

DIVIDE & REPLANT PERENNIALS (DAISIES, DAYLILIES, IRIS,)

DIG UP FOR STORAGE INDOORS DAHLIA, GLADIOLUS, CANNAS etc

PRUNING

PRUNE WITH SHARP TOOLS ANY DEAD, DISEASED, DAMAGED OR CROSS BRANCHING LIMBS. WAIT TILL MID WINTER OR EARLY SPRING FOR MORE AGGRESSIVE PRUNING.

DEAD HEAD HERBACEOUS PLANTS. REMOVE STEMS & LEAVES

TOOLS

DRAIN FUEL, OIL SPARKS PLUG, SHARPEN BLADES AND CLEAN OFF ANY DEBRIS GOOD TIME TO HAVE MOWERS SERVICED

PESTS

ANY PLANTS THAT HAD PROBLEM LAST SUMMER, CLEAN UP LEAVES AND DISPOSE OF.

WRAP PLANTS THAT ARE FAVORED BY RODENTS

POISON BAIT MOST EFFECTIVE. FOLLOW DIRECTIONS

APPLY LIQUID FENCE TO PROTECT PLANTS

STORE PESTICIDES IN SIDE AWAY FROM FREEZING, SUNLIGHT AND MOISTURE.
