Triple Crown may run away from the competition as it gets better known. It gets its name from three crowing attributes: flavor, productivity and vigor.

Plants yield large, glossy, tasty, black fruits that are pleasantly firm and able to withstand shipping.

Plants are semi-erect and thornless. Vigorous vines can grow 12-15 feet in a season.

Triple Crown is a joint release from U.S.D.A.-Beltsville and the Pacific West Agricultural Research Service.

Ripens: Mid July to mid August

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
